



## Version 7.0.2.b – Release Notes

The *PostalOne!* 7.0.2.b release is scheduled for mid-September, and affects the following areas:

### Data Exchange

The *PostalOne!* data exchange servers accepting Mail.dat files have been restored to the 6.0.0.c version while issues with the latest version are resolved. The only functional change is that the servers no longer generate receipt files for postage statements canceled over the Web; mailers can expect servers to process files as they did prior to September 5, 2004. This change affects batch processing.

### e-VS

The following changes are to Electronic Verification System (e-VS) reports available when logged on the *PostalOne!* system as an e-VS Customer user.

- The Manifest Summary report now offers a link to a page with PIC and postage amount for each filtered/duplicate record along with the amount of postage for all the filtered duplicate records. To view the new page, click the count of a filtered or duplicate record.
- The Mis-shipped Mail Report is now based on the date of the sample (“event date”) to ensure mail appears in the correct time period if loaded late.
- One new report is available for e-VS mailings. The Product Tracking System Unmanifested Records Report lists mailings not included in a manifest. PRS mailings are not included.
- The PRS Return Delivery Unit (RDU) Summary Report is no longer available.
- Two new reports, Filtered Sample Report and the Sample Duplicate Exception Report are available for sampling issue reporting on PRS mailings. A new report, the RBMC Postage Statement Summary Report, displays postage due information for PRS mailings.

To view the RBMC report, open a postage statement, then click the transmission date. To view all other reports, click **e-VS Reports** on the left menu bar. Select the area to view, then click **Next**. Select the district and time period you wish to view, then click **Next**. Click the report title.

### Previous Changes

The following changes occurred in a previous release:

- The logon page has a new style. Users should continue to use their existing usernames and passwords to log on the *PostalOne!* system. This change affects all users.
- The *PostalOne!* system now allows nonidentical Parcel Post® mailings to claim both the oversized rate and the balloon rate. Previously, Parcel Post mailings could claim one rate or the other, but not both. This change affects all Postage Statement Wizard® software users.
- The Owners features available prior to 7.0.2 have been restored. The preview of future Owner functionality released with 7.0.2 has been removed. This affects all Owner users.
